

## 2009 Credit Union Charity Ride

Poker Run Rules. (Rules are subject to change up until the beginning of the event)

### **General Description**

This will be a poker run style ride, with Participants going to several destinations to collect their poker hand. At the beginning of the run, Participants will be given a "score card" to carry with them throughout the event. At each stop, a card will be drawn from a deck of cards. The drawn card will be recorded by an event volunteer and given back to the Participant for the next pit stop. Cards will be drawn at the starting point, three pit stops, and the final destination.

### **Terms Used**

**"Poker"** – use of the term Poker to describe this charitable event should not be misconstrued as being a form of gambling. This event is effectively a "chance drawing" type event to raise funds for Doernbecher Children's Hospital. The act of drawing cards is merely a colorful variation of a traditional raffle, to custom create a "chance drawing" ticket number. The chances of winning a prize are no different for this event than for a traditional raffle.

**"Participant"** – The term Participant describes a driver and/or passenger of a motorized vehicle that has completed, in full, a registration form and release of liability. Any person operating a vehicle near, or around, Participants, without completing the necessary forms, is merely another person driving on public roads. Due to the nature of the grand prize for this event, all participants must be 21 years of age, or older.

**"Walk In"** – The term Walk In describes a driver or passenger of a vehicle that arrives at the final destination, regardless of the type of vehicle or their starting point, to partake in the festivities at that location.

### **Fees**

Entry fee to participate in the poker run is \$30.00 (\$25.00 for pre-registrations). Included in the entry fee are one poker hand score card, one event T-shirt, one event pin, and one meal. To increase the odds of winning, additional score cards may be purchased for \$15.00. If additional shirts are desired, they may be purchased for \$25.00. Passengers can also purchase a participant package for the same price as a regular registration. Proceeds for this event will go to Doernbecher Children's Hospital.

### **Registration**

Registration begins at 8:00 am at iQ Credit Union in Camas, Washington. Once a Participant is registered, they are free to begin the ride to the first pit stop. Participants are encouraged to ride in smaller groups for safety's sake. There will not be any "escorts", "road captains", or "leaders", therefore keeping the groups smaller, and perhaps with folks the Participant is familiar with, will keep the ride as safe as possible. It is the responsibility of the rider to ride within their limits and recognize unsafe situations.

Score cards will not be given to motorcyclists without the registration form and release of liability form completed in full. Poker hands must be tallied on the official score card – no substitutions. Riders that choose to travel to the final destination and purchase score cards at that location are not considered Participants of the charity ride, they will be considered a "walk in" attendee.

**Final Destination**

The poker run will end at Fibre Federal Credit Union, where entertainment and refreshments will be provided.

Once the Participant arrives, they will need to get their final card drawn to complete their hand.

Walk In (non riding) participants can purchase a rider package, or individual items as they wish, for the same price structure.

**Scoring**

We will use the rules of straight five card poker to tally the score cards. No wild cards, nothing fancy.

In the unlikely event that two Participants have the exact same high score hand, the tie will be broken by a simple single card draw. High card will win the grand prize, and the second prize will go to the low card. Ace is high.

Hand rank, in order of highest to lowest:

Royal Flush

Straight Flush

Four of a Kind

Full House

Flush

Straight

Three of a kind

Two pair

Pair

Five of a kind is not a valid hand, and will be scored as a four of a kind hand.
